Family tree of the Delcò (Delco) families (Daro, Bellinzona – Switzerland)

Dear Madam, dear Sir,

I am sending this letter to you, because I'm trying to complete the genealogic tree of my family, the **Delcò** family, from Daro, Bellinzona in Switzerland.

Out of this area and in foreign countries the family name lost the accent on the "o", so now I'm writing to all Delco families in the USA to determinate who are ancestors of the **Delco's** from Switzerland.

From an internet research and some contact with families, I found out that the Delco's living today in the USA have different origins: From Italy (Delco or Del Colle changed to Delco), Greece (Delcos), from a change of the family name Dalcourt. It is certain that some Delco have Swiss origin too and the link to my family in this case is direct. On the Internet I found some ancestor trace too and you can see it on the next pages.

It is for this matter, that I am asking you to help me with this research:

- If you are sure, your family does not have a Swiss origin: Please fill out only the first part of the form (1 & 1a) and re-mail it to me or send me an e-mail. (info@delcofamily.ch), so I'll be able to eliminate you from my contacts. In that case I thank you for your time in reading and replying to my letter.
- If you are sure, your family has a Swiss origin or you are not sure about the origin:
 I kindly ask you to fill out the form with all possible personal data, that will allow me to put
 the different families into the tree and complete or correct mistakes.
 I am aware that I'm asking personal information, and the choice to fill out the form or not is
 yours alone. If you decide to respond, please fill in as much data as possible. Non the less
 partially filled forms will help me too!

You can return the papers with the enclosed envelope. All of your information will be treated very confidentially and used only for the purpose described above.

If you mark 1b, I will inform you as soon as possible if descendants have Swiss origins from Daro. It would be my pleasure if you would contact me to view the actual genealogic tree, it is possible to view it on the web too.

I am also putting together material to print a booklet that will tell the history of the family and the village of Daro. I will be happy with all documents or copies of documents, (birth certificates, certificates of family, ecc...) newspaper clippings, pictures (possibly originals – I will return them to you as soon as I will have digitalized them), ... Who am I:

My name is David Delcò, born may 19 1970, I live in Piazzogna, canton Ticino, in the south of Switzerland. this is the only italian speaking area of Switzerland.

My parents are Graziella born Börlin and Ivo Delcò. The origin of my family is in Daro – Bellinzona. The outline of my family is listed below.

After completed my education I now work as an Emergency Medical Technician and instructor in Locarno, a town on the lake Maggiore. I'm also Emergency first responder for the area where I live. The name of this area is Gambarogno and it is on the other site of the lake in front of Locarno.

I'm a Town councilor and the family participate to the "Patriziato" of Daro (in Switzerland "patrizi" are the definition for the families that live in an area more than a century)

In the year 2000 I began the research on my family and I collected a lot of information thanks to the Church archive, Clerk offices and state institution that permitted me to have now an outline from 1530 until today. I like history and genealogy and hope you can help me with this..








- Giuseppe <u>Rodolfo</u> Delcò (<u>Rudolph</u> Delco), arrived in New York on may 4 1891 from port of Le Havre (France) on the boat "La Gascogne". He was born abt. 1868 in Daro, Switzerland. He didn't stay a long time in the USA and returned to Switzerland.
- Rodolfo Francesco Delcò (Rudolph Francis Delco), (Son of Giuseppe Rodolfo Delcò) arrived in New York on November 19 1921 from port of Le Havre (France) on the boat "Paris". He was born march 8 1898 in Melide, Switzerland. He married to Alma L. abt. 1924. He worked as a creamery. They had 3 sons all born in California: Conrad R., born 1927, William F., born 1928 and Wendall E., born 1929. In 1930 (US Federal Census) They lived in Santa Maria, Santa Barbara County, State of California, USA.
- Giovanni <u>Pietro</u> Delcò (Peter Delco), arrived in the USA in 1892. He was born on April 21 1865 in Castione, Switzerland. He married April 9 1890, in Lumino, Switzerland, to Maria (said Marietta) Dellamonica. They had 5 children: Maria (said Marietta too), born September 27 1890 and Pietro Luigi (Peter Jr.) born august 25 1892, both born in Lumino, Switzerland and emigrated to the USA with their mother, arrived February 6 1893 on the boat "La Bretagne" from port of Le Havre, France. The other 3 children: <u>Enedina</u> (Ena Dina) born march 5 1894, <u>Fredewinda</u> (Fredis) born abt. 1896 and <u>Severina</u> born abt. 1898 was born in California. <u>Maria</u> jr. (Marietta) married abt. 1920 to Edward Robert Muttersbach.
 Ena Dina married abt. 1926 to Chester Albert Creps, she died April 21 1993 in California Peter Died July 23 1944 in California, Marietta died march 18 1914 in California. (US Federal Census 1900, 1920, 1930)
 <u>Peter</u> and <u>Marietta</u> were buried in the Old Holy Cross Cemetery, Santa Cruz County, California, USA. There is a picture of this burial available on internet at URL www.findagrave.com.
- <u>Maria</u> Delcò (Mary Delco), arrived in the USA in 1913. She was born in Switzerland abt. 1888. She is listed in US Federal Census of 1920 and 1930. On those documents she's listed as a Superior teacher in a private school. She lived in Chicago, Cook County, State of Illinois, USA. It's not clear what the relationship is with other family members.
- <u>Alessio</u> Delcò, arrived in the USA December 4 1893. He was born in Switzerland abt. 1874. Arrived from port of Le Havre (France) on the boat "La Bourgogne". He married but didn't stay in the USA and probably returned to Switzerland (No record on 1900 US Federal Census).
